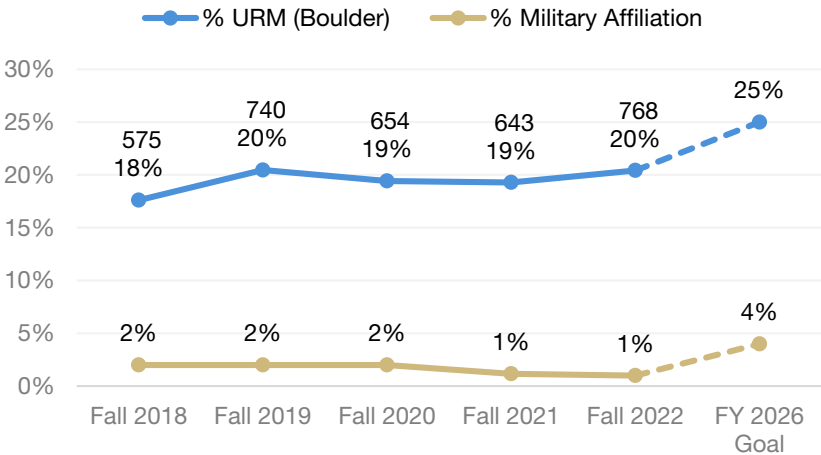

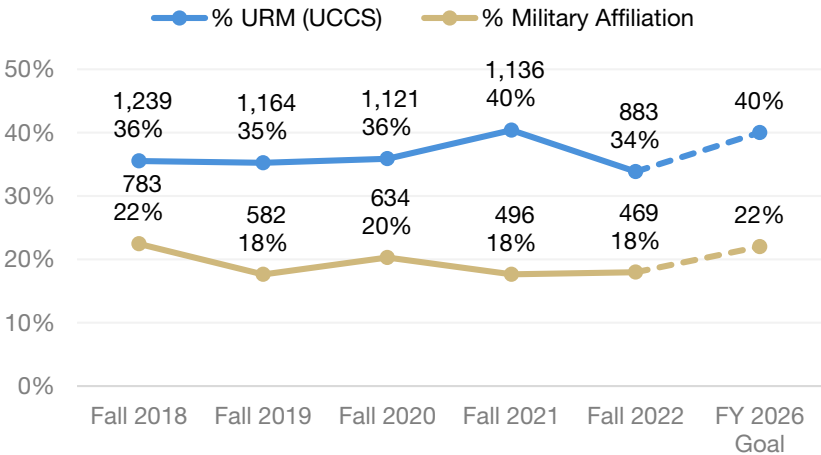

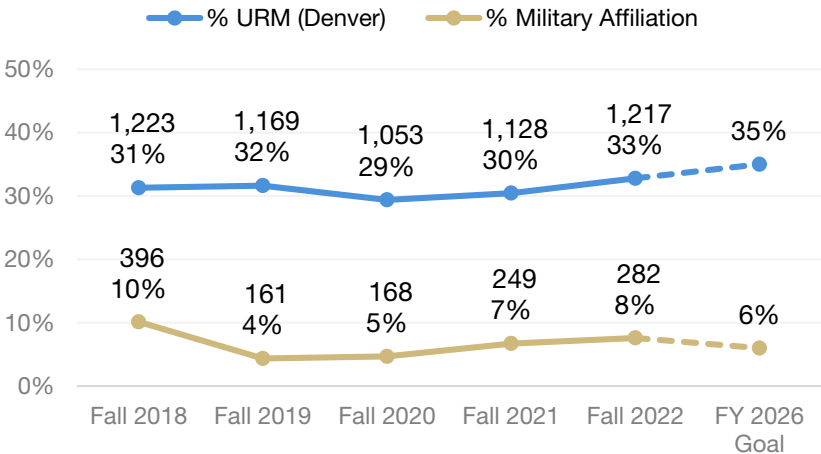

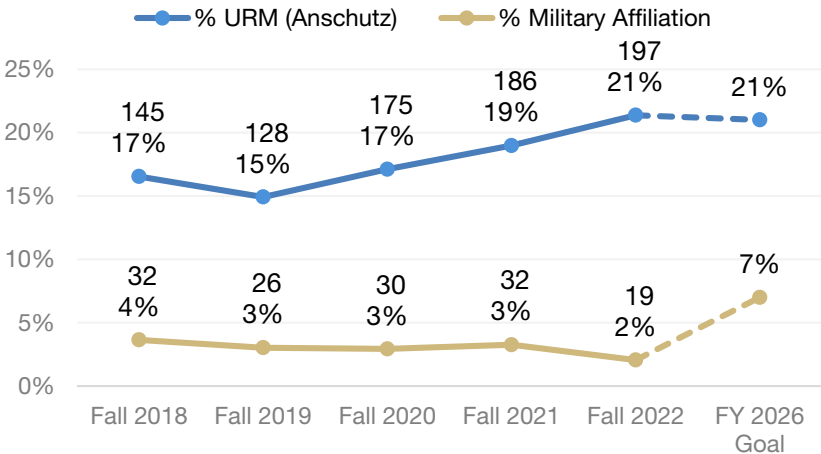
UCCS: New Student Diversity



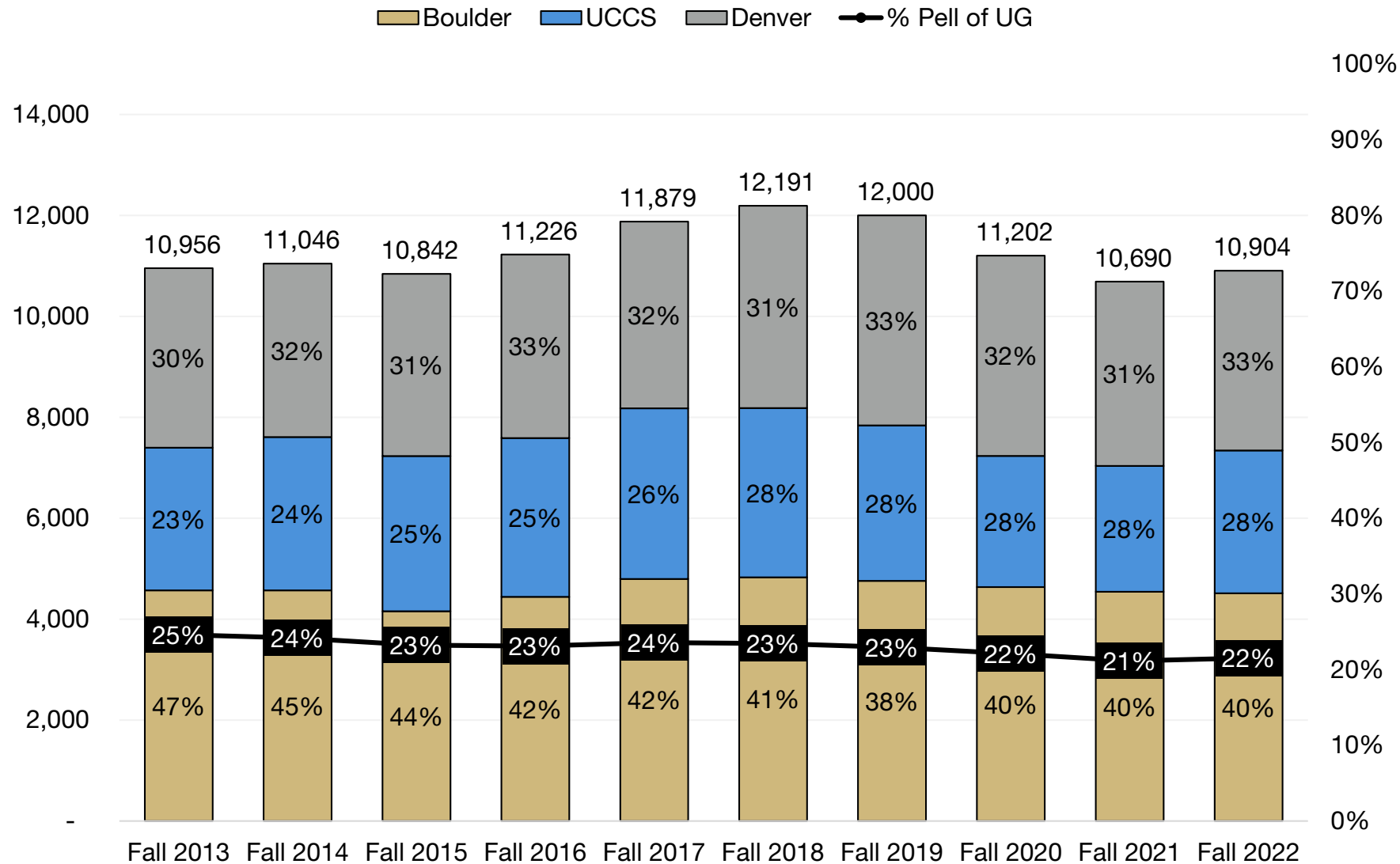

Student Enrollment Diversity | Pell Recipients

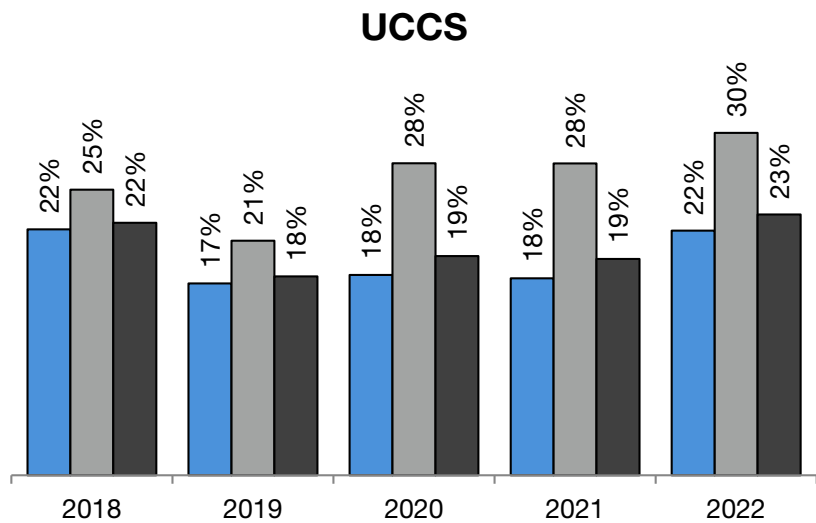

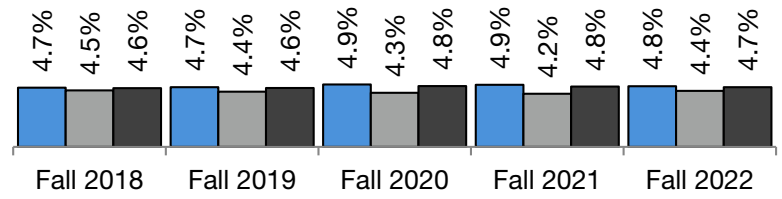

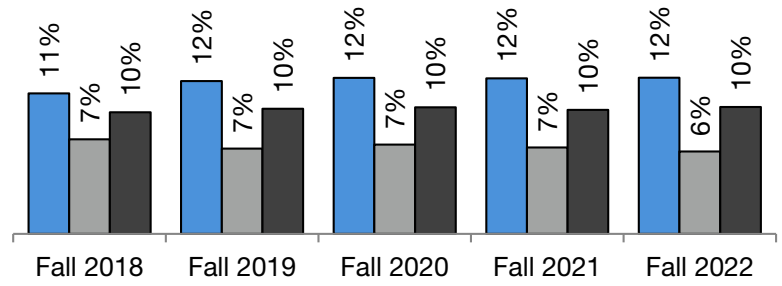

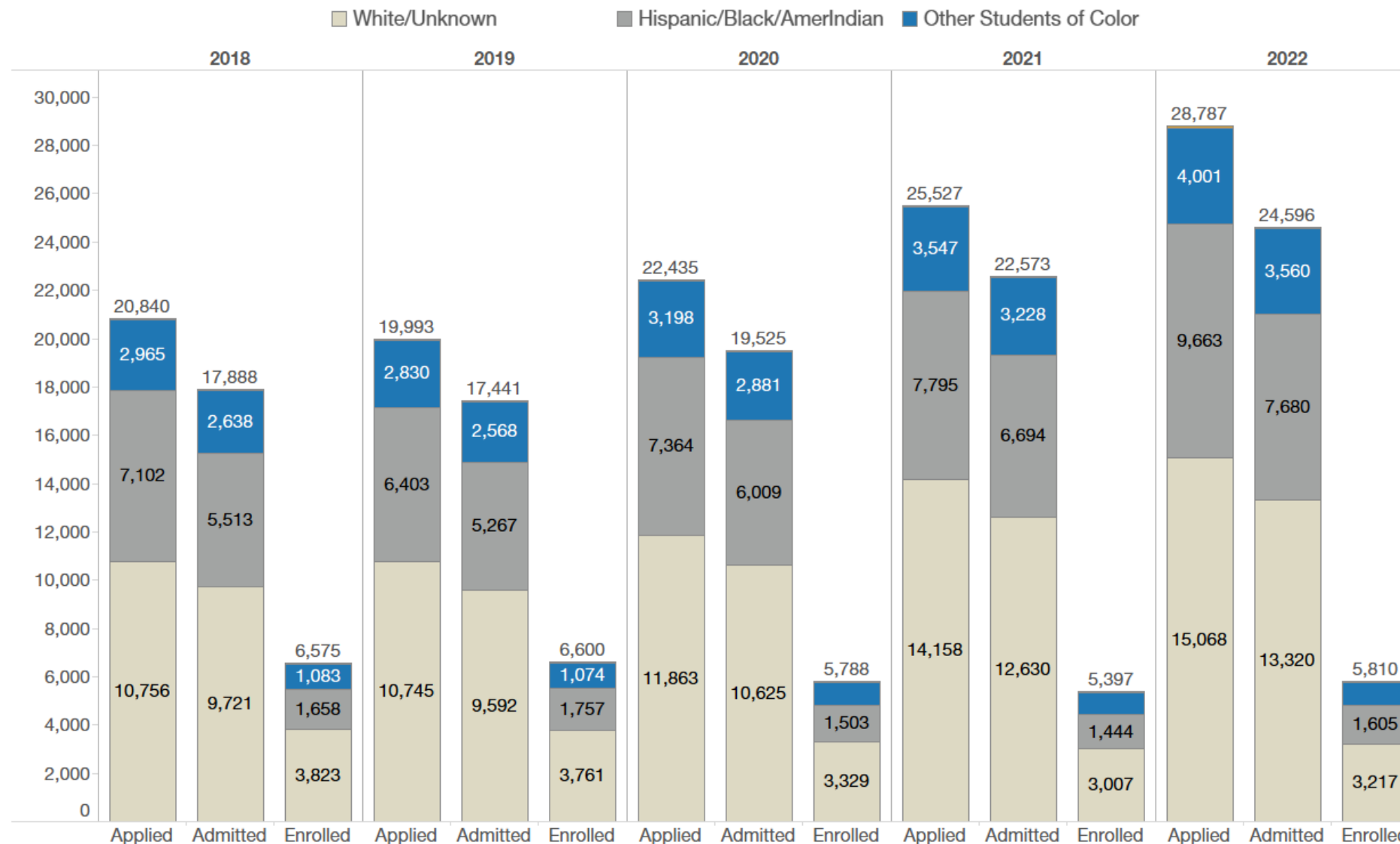

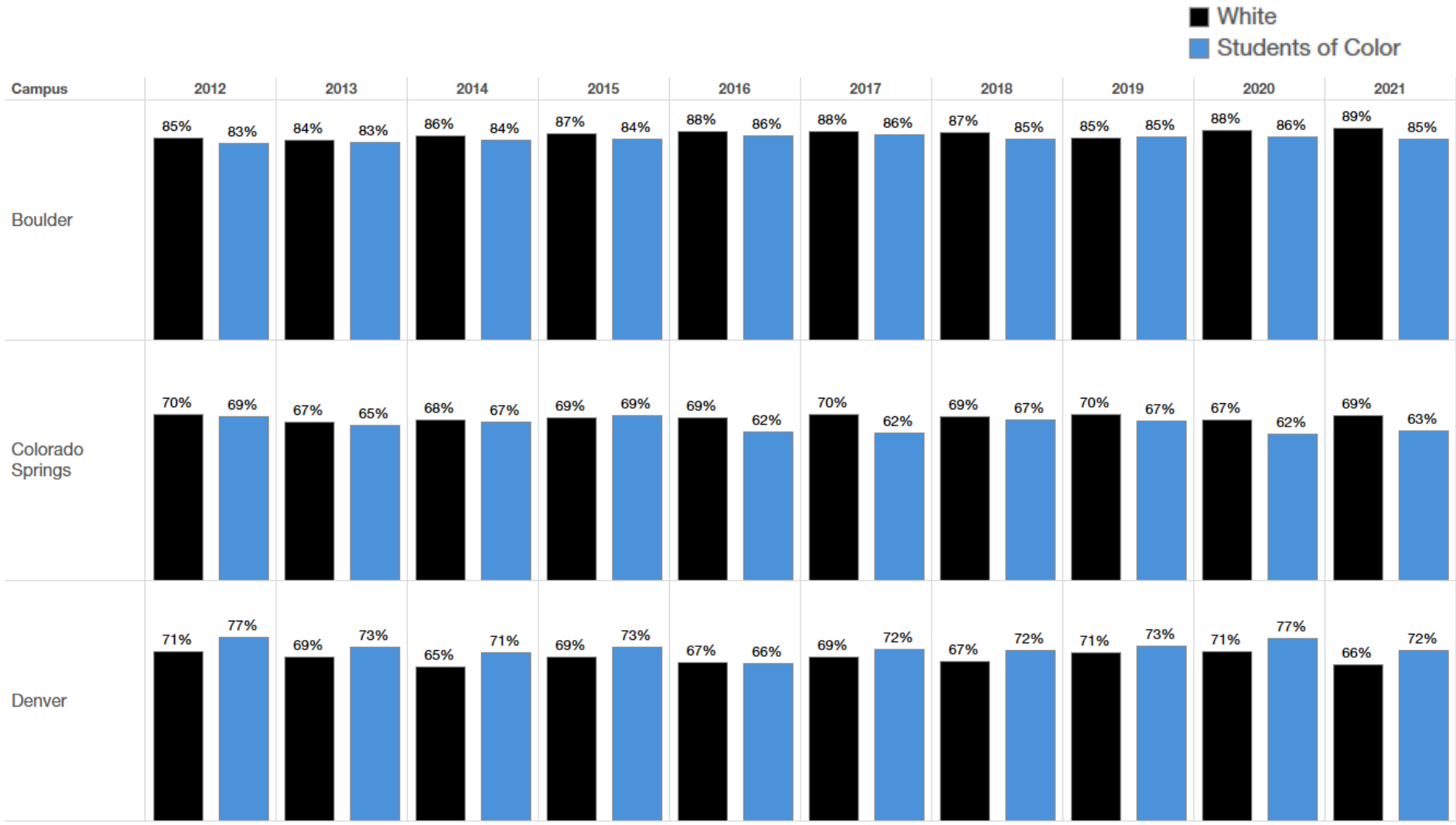

First-time, full-time freshman in fall term returning for second fall



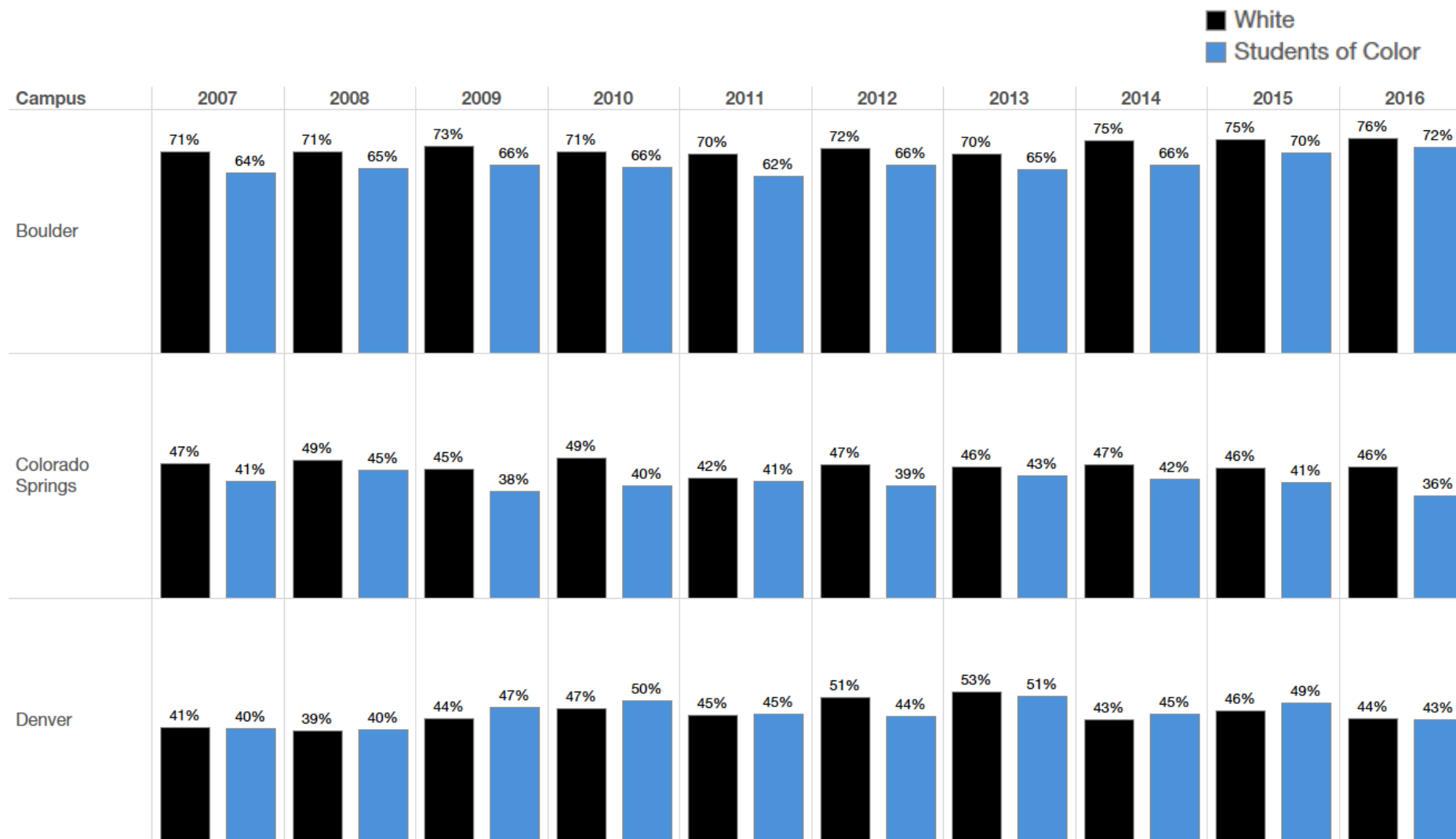

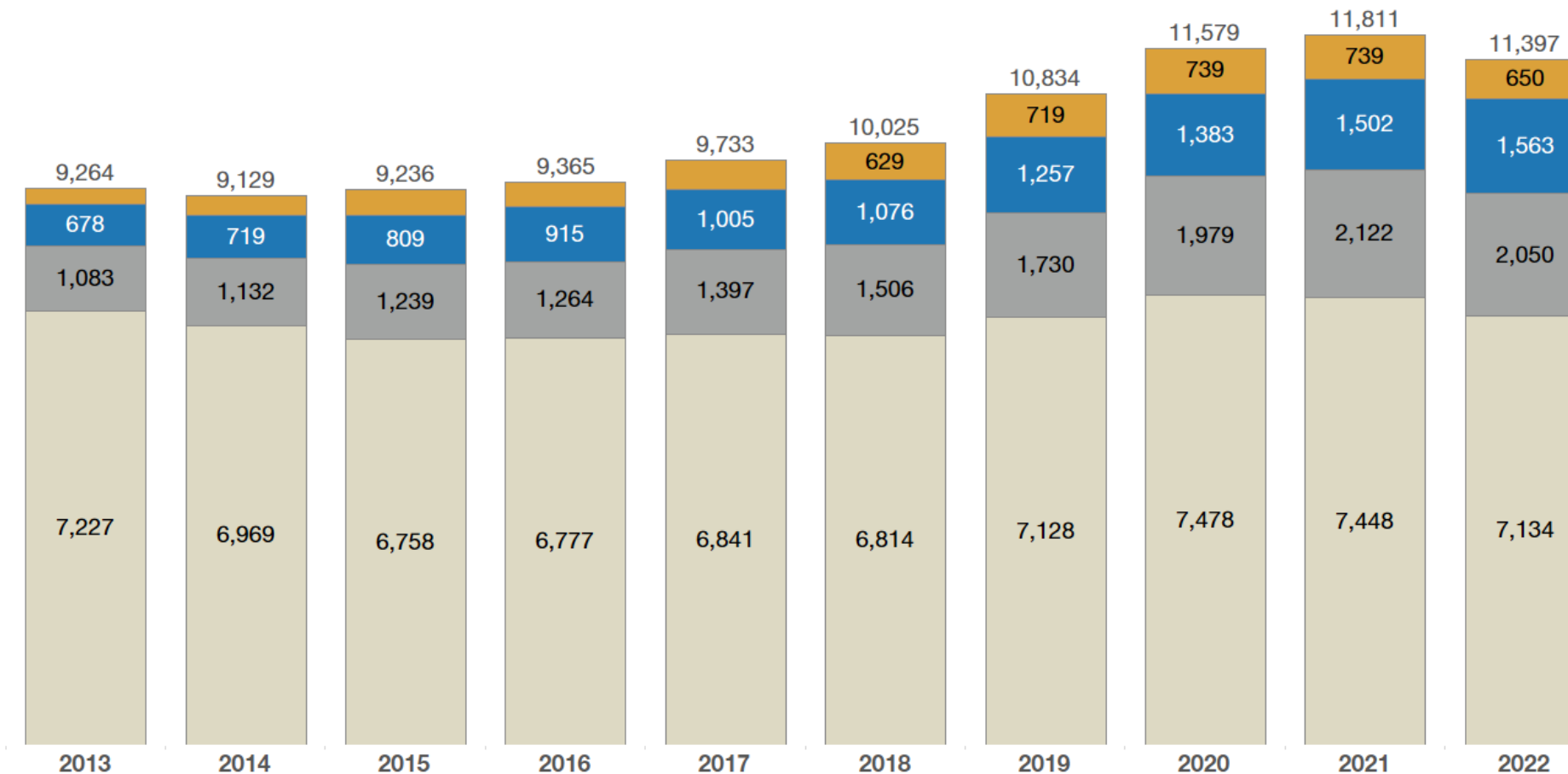
