f: Incoming students only. Tuition for continuing students will remain flat from FY 2019 to FY 2020.

g: Students are automatically placed in a tuition guarantee group based on their first term enrolled at CU Boulder as a degree- or licensure-seeking nonresident oncampus student. The tuition guarantee group covers both new freshmen and transfers and is not affected by class standing at entry. "On-campus" excludes students on study abroad and students taking only continuing education courses (also called extended studies courses).
