





Fall Headcount Enrollment History Fall 2000 to Fall 2012 Estimate*


University of Colorado Student Headcount Enrollment Fall 2000 to Fall 2012*

Enrollment Highlights – Boulder

Fall 2012 Preliminary Estimate (pre-census)

- New freshman at about 5,500
 - Consistent with historic levels
 - Pressures include out of state recruiters
- Diversity increasing 22% of new freshmen are students of color, with
 - African-American up over 20%, to over 130
 - American Indian up 14%, to around 90
 - Asian-American up 10%, to over 375
- International up 14% to over 1,900
 - Including a more than 30% increase in new freshmen international

Enrollment Highlights – Colorado Springs Fall 2012 Census Preliminary Estimate

- Largest incoming class in history
 - 1449 new freshmen = 7.2% increase
 - 1102 new transfers = 14.1% increase
- Non-resident enrollment up 24.7%
- Military enrollment up 18.0%
- WUE enrollment up 60.0%
- Main campus credit hours up 5.6%

Enrollment Highlights – Denver Fall 2012 Census Preliminary Estimate

- Overall fall 2012 enrollment is expected to be close to budgeted enrollment of 14,491 once the census report is published September 14.
- New freshman are estimated to be near 1,000, which is on par with the past few years but up 9% over fall 2011.
- Enrollments for undergraduates overall (approximately 9,792) are also on par with recent history, although nonresident undergraduates are up 19%.
- New transfers are slightly higher than last year at approximately 1,352.
- Minority enrollment is up 5%.
- Graduate enrollment is estimated to be 4,542, a decline from the last three years, but nonresident graduate students are 19% over last year, and international students specifically are up 6%.

Anschutz Medical Campus Enrollment Update*

Enrollment Highlights – Anschutz Medical Campus Fall 2012 Preliminary Estimate (pre-census)

- For the entire Anschutz Campus, currently there are 3,564 enrollments, which is 2.4% over the prior year of 3,481. There are nearly 700 new students joining the campus this fall, which is on par with prior year.
- Minority enrollment on the Campus is up 14%.
- An estimated 493 are enrolled in undergraduate nursing programs, which is a 20% increase over fall 2011.
- 3,071 students are currently enrolled in graduate and professional programs at the Anschutz Campus, which is the same as prior year.
- Preliminary reports indicate that enrollment in the School of Dental Medicine is up 12%, Colorado School of Public Health degree-seeking program enrollment is up 8%. Enrollments in the Schools of Medicine and Skaggs Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences have modest increases of 1% to 2%.
